Getting it right matters!

Does it matter whether you receive precisely what you ask for?

Well, if you order a hamburger with pickles and ketchup, and they add mustard too, that might be annoying, but it's not a big deal.

What about when you go to the pharmacy to pick up your prescription? Let's suppose your doctor prescribed a specific medicine to treat your illness. Would you be satisfied if the pharmacist just gave you any pills off the shelf, because after all, "they are all medicine".

No! You want the specific medicine you asked for, to treat your specific need.

What about the confessions of a church? Sometimes you hear people say, "It doesn't really matter what your church teaches so long as you believe in Jesus."

But that's not what Jesus taught us. When he gave us the Great Commission, calling us to make disciples of all nations, he added, "teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." Matthew 28:20

We don't want to be unclear about the medicine we receive at the drugstore, and we don't want to be unclear about the confessions we hold to, and the truths from Scripture we share with others. We want to proclaim God's truth clearly! Doctrines matter, confessions need to clear, truth needs to be embraced, and false teachings need to be rejected. Jesus emphasized this in the Lord's Prayer as well when he taught to pray, "Father, hallowed be your name!" God's name is his titles and everything he tells us about himself in his Word. Our love for God extends to our love for his Word. We honor God when we hold to the truth, defend the truth, speak the truth, live by the truth, and share God's precious truth with others.

As individual Christians, a church family, and a worldwide church body, may we always insist on receiving the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, so that God's name may be glorified and God's people edified. Then the apostle John can say of us what he said to his hearers in

3 John 1:4 "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth." Pastor Robert Hein
