Sunday Bible Classes at 9:15 am through May 19th

The Heart of the Bible: Learning to Love the Book of Psalms - At the center of the Bible lies the book of Psalms. This poetic heart of the Scriptures has served as the hymnal of God's people for roughly three thousand years. Jesus spoke and sang psalms often, even quoting them from the cross. This 6-week course seeks to grow your love for the Psalms and to reveal our Savior's love for us through them.
