Tam the Good Shepherd. The good Shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

There is singing in your future!

That's no surprise, we're Lutheran. Soon the new hymnals will appear in our pews, We'll have familiar and new hymns to sing. Our midweek worship and the Women's Ministry "Advent By Candlelight" will focus on the Songs of Advent. The writers of the Psalms loved to encourage God's people to sing.

Zephaniah's call to sing in chapter 3 begins with something familiar. Sing, O Daughter of Zion; shout aloud, O Israel! Be glad and rejoice with all your heart, O Daughter of Jerusalem!

Next comes the reminder that when we sing for joy, it is joy for a reason, joy for what God has done and in knowing he is with us.

- 15 The LORD has taken away your punishment, he has turned back your enemy. The LORD, the King of Israel, is with you; never again will you fear any harm.
- ¹⁶ On that day they will say to Jerusalem, "Do not fear, O Zion; do not let your hands hang limp. 17 The LORD your God is with you, he is mighty

Next the prophet Zephaniah adds an incredible promise about the singing in your future. Here is something worth pondering quietly before moving on: He will take great delight in you, he will quiet you with his love, he will rejoice over you with singing."

Wait a minute! Who is going to sing? The LORD!

The saints and angels in heaven will sing, but they are, if you will, the opening act for the creator of music to sing with joy. Note that the LORD will sing for joy because he also has a reason for joy. Here comes the great surprise of the Gospel. Here is a reminder of how confident we can be because Christ came down to cover our guilt and reveal his Father's gracious heart.

Where will the LORD find joy? In you! When your conscience has accused you and done its necessary work, Satan, the accuser jumps in and continues with his song of death. The Lord will interrupt that and guiet you with his love. And then he will sing! He will sing to express his joy over you! Yes, you!
