

Call Update – Our Voters' Call meeting for a third pastor advising the Board of Worship and Support, which includes Stewardship ministry will be Sunday, July 24th at 11:00 am. We have received an MLC graduate, Mrs. Madison Boulden to replace Mr. Kramer to teach in the upper grades. We are very excited to have Mrs. Boulden join our staff! We welcome Hannah Swiontek, a Wisconsin Lutheran College graduate, who will serve as an instructional teacher here. We look forward to adding her to our team!

Enrollment in K3-8 has increased by about 25 students to approximately 260. What a great opportunity to provide more children with a Christ- centered education! Our 4K enrollment is approximately 31 so we will continue to have two classrooms. We have made significant investments in technology for the coming school year: We have added 50 additional Chromebooks which will provide 1 to 1 Chromebook usage in grades 3-8. In addition, this will allow us to expand Chromebook usage in grades K-2. We are also thrilled to purchase 50 more Apple iPads to be used for students in preschool to grade 2.

Two new office/classroom spaces are being added in the commons area. New classroom furniture will be seen throughout the school. Many student desks and chairs were updated again in our classrooms. The 7th grade room is being remodeled with new carpeting and shelving. It looks great! What a great staff we have at Good Shepherd School! It was a blessing to have our entire staff lead us through this past school year with wisdom and grace! As we begin another year, please continue to keep our incredible Good Shepherd School staff in your prayers. What a blessing we have in these workers!
