# Faith Too Weak?

In the midst of the electrical storm, the power went out. I quickly reached for the oil lamp on the fireplace mantel and lit it. At first it smoldered, giving off little light until I adjusted the wick. At times, like when a serious problem leads to a lengthy hospital stay, we might feel that our faith is like that smoldering wick. It just doesn't seem to burn brightly, but instead to flicker uncertainly. We might even be concerned that our faith is too weak.

Be careful, my friend. When God writes out his million dollar check of salvation, its worth doesn't depend on the hand that holds it. Whether that hand of faith is weak or strong, the check is still good. God has deposited in the bank of heaven the riches of Christ's payment for all sin. In his love God wrote our name on the check when he brought us to faith. His signature on the bottom of the check assures me that the million dollars is there for me. Not the condition of my faith, but Christ's payment for all my sins saves me.

My loving God does, however, want my hold on his check to grow stronger. Or as Isaiah put it, he won't blow out a flickering faith, but trims the wick so that it burns more brightly (Isaiah 42:3). My heavenly Father even reminds me how he does this. It is through the power of the Gospel in his Word and Sacraments. When I worry about my faith, I can do nothing better than to turn to them for faith's strengthening. The approaching summer season is no time to take leave from using his powerful Word and Sacrament.
