Building "People" Connections Update We are grateful that 256 families/ individuals have promised \$970,407

towards our Building People Connections campaign to reduce or eliminate our \$1.2 million expansion mortgage. \$897,515 has already been received. Our expansion mortgage is now down to \$179,050.
