Good Shepherd Lutheran School Update

- We were blessed to serve 251 students in our preschool to grade 8 where children heard God's truth shared with them daily.
- Our partnership with Shepherd of the Hills continues to grow. Of our 251 students in K3-8 attending our school, approximately 25% are from Shepherd of the Hills and that number continues to grow.
- In technology, we updated our Wi-Fi access points for students, added 60 additional Chromebooks for students and were also thrilled to purchase 50 Apple iPads to be used for students in preschool to grade 2 this past school year.
- Our school is blessed with growth! Early projections for next year indicate a substantial increase in enrollment to approximately 260. Two new classroom spaces are being added in the downstairs commons area and we officially started a building committee to add classrooms, church meeting rooms, and possibly a new gym in the future.
- Our 4K enrollment this last school year was approximately 30 which caused us to add another classroom and teacher to split that large group into two classrooms. In addition, we added a second Kindergarten classroom and teacher to accommodate 31 K students this past school year.

And this next school year, we have made plans to add another first grade classroom and teacher.

- Approximately 50% of the tuition of each student attending Good Shepherd School is funded through the generous support we receive from our members and school parents at Shepherd of the Hills and Good Shepherd. We thank you and ask that you continue to pray for and support our school's ministry to the next generation! Thank you to the members of Good Shepherd and Shepherd of the Hills for your support on the one thing needful!
- As we begin another year, please continue to keep our incredible Good Shepherd School staff in your prayers. What a blessing we have in these workers! Give Thanks to the Lord for he is good!
