### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Good Shepherd members, whose children attend Good Shepherd Lutheran School, are eligible.
- Parents must agree to pay all registration fees.
- Parents must submit a new application form each year to request financial assistance.
- A written plan for payment of any prior year's outstanding balance must be made before a student, or assistance, will be considered.
- Good Shepherd Lutheran School admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all
  the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the
  school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in
  administration of its educational policies, admissions policies and athletic and other schooladministered programs.

### HOW IS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE DETERMINED?

- The tuition assistance program of Good Shepherd is a "need-based" aid program.
- All families are expected to contribute some amount toward the Christian education of their children.
- The Tuition Assistance Committee, made up of a pastor, the principal, and a representative of the Board of Lutheran Schools, will review all applications.
- In addition to financial need, the criteria to award tuition assistance is also based on the family's participation in the spiritual training of the student as demonstrated by frequent and regular church attendance and good home-school cooperation.
- All information remains confidential.
- The Committee reserves the right to adjust financial aid as family circumstances change.

### STATEMENT OF AGREEMENTS

### We recognize that:

- The Good Shepherd Lutheran School Tuition Assistance Program is funded by gifts of the members of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church.
- Good Shepherd's Tuition Assistance Program was established to provide financial support for those parent(s)/guardian(s) who are members of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church and are financially unable to pay the full tuition for Christian education at Good Shepherd Lutheran School.
- Each family's financial situation will be examined individually and confidentially by the Tuition Assistance Committee and a determination will be made as to the support given by the Tuition Assistance Program and the support paid by the parent(s)/guardian(s).
- This Tuition Assistance Application applies only to current tuition. It does not apply to registration, past due
  accounts, or any fees. If there is an outstanding balance, there must be a written plan in place for payment of
  that balance.
- We understand that if we do not keep current on tuition, the child's enrollment may be terminated. In addition all tuition must be current in order to enroll for the new school year.
- If changes in income occur during the time of tuition assistance which would increase or decrease our ability
  to handle the school tuition, we need to contact the Tuition Assistance Committee so proper adjustments can
  be made.
- This Tuition Assistance Application is for this school year only and a new Tuition Assistance Application must be submitted each school year if continued assistance is needed.
- The purpose of Christian education is to help each child grow in his understanding of God's Word so that he/she may remain strong in the faith and serve God with a life of Christian service. This education takes place in the school, in the church, and in the home. Out of concern for our spiritual welfare, we will strive to worship together as a family each weekend.
- Regular church attendance and financial need is considered when determining assistance allocations.
- The information we have provided in this application form is reviewed only by the Tuition Assistance Committee (a pastor, the principal, and a Board of Lutheran Schools representative) and will be held in strictest confidence.
